DON'T BE BLINDED TO GOD'S HELP

Hey folks, who of us has asked for help from God? Answer: All of us! So how often do you think God sends us help? Answer: Every time we ask! The thing is, it might not be in the form of what we're thinking. Have you ever heard the story about the rains that came and the man ends up on the roof of his house? A boat comes by and tries to save the man but he responds with, "No... God will save me." Then a helicopter flies over and drops a rope and again he responds with, "No...God will save me." Well, unfortunately, the man drowns. When he see`s God he asks, "Why didn`t you save me?", in which God replies, "I tried. I sent you a boat AND a helicopter, but you declined both." Don`t be blinded to God`s help. We get caught up in looking for "exactly" what "we" want and not the solution that God has for us. So when God answers us with something a little different, or a lot different, don`t just decline it and wait for another response, accept the help and don`t be blinded to the help God has provided.
