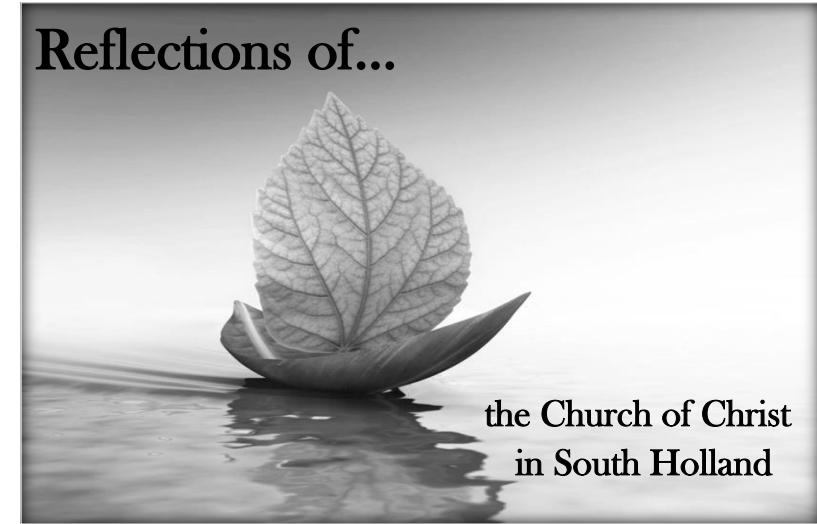

Five Bedrock Truths for Our Lives - R. Webster

1. Loyalty to Christ and the Scriptures - We must commit ourselves to follow Christ through his word. You just cannot have one without the other. Like two wings on a bird, loyalty to Christ and the Scriptures work in tandem. "*Lord to whom (else) shall we go? You have the words of eternal life.*" ([John 6:68b](#))
2. Commitment to the Great Commission - The Holy Spirit working in us in winning the lost and edifying the saved: "*Go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age.*" ([Matt. 28:19, 20](#))
3. Trusting in the Promises of God - God has given us His "*great and precious promises, so that through them you may participate in the divine nature.*" ([2 Peter 1:4](#)) The promises of God are foundational to our faith, giving us hope and the ability to believe God for the furtherance of His Kingdom. Without the promises, we end in despair.
4. A Pledge to Spiritual Reproduction - This requires selflessness and sacrifice. Investing your life in that of another. Christ invested in The Twelve. Paul invested in Timothy: "*The things you have heard me say... entrust to reliable men who will also be qualified to teach others also.*" ([2 Timothy 2:2](#)) *Each one teach one!*
5. A Complete Reliance on Prayer. We must never forget that our journey as children of God will be plagued with obstacles designed to test or even discourage us. Therefore, Jesus exhorts us to "*always pray and not to lose heart.*" ([Luke 18:1](#))
