HELLO, MY NAME IS ...

Ed, Laura, Tommie, John, Bonnie, and I just returned from the Freed-Hardeman Univ. lectureship looking for prospects for a new preacher for South Holland. While there, each day we wore ID badges with our names and home towns on them.

This is not an article on the thinking that everyone should wear an ID badge every day (which we older folks would like to see implemented). That might be a possible abuse of one's personal identity outside the circle of his friends, family, and co-workers. However, there is one name that should be known by all.

God, the creator of the universe and all that is in it, the One often spoken of as our Father, identified Himself by the name YHWH (Ex. 6:3). This is a Hebrew language word most often pronounced "Yahweh", or "Jehovah" in the American Standard Version. Newer translations use the word LORD, written in all uppercase letters when the name YHWH is in the Hebrew text. What does YHWH mean? "He is" or "He causes to be." "He is" the God who keeps His covenant. He is the God Who "causes all things to be." We know Him as God, the Mighty One, the ruler over all the created universe. He is "Lord", as the sovereign king. He is El Shaddai (God Almighty). And He is YHWH Elohim (Gen 2:4), the LORD God as the creator of the universe Who enters into a covenant relationship with us.

Quite simply, He is YHWH, Yahweh. But it is not that simple. Reading His revelation, the Bible, only begins to open up our understanding of Who He is. He cannot just put His name on an ID badge. Words will ultimately fail to identify Him completely. If I know Him through His Son Jesus, then that is enough. After all, Jesus said that if I see Him, I see the Father (Jn. 14:9).

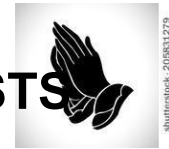
